Recreational League Player/Parent Code of Conduct:

The purpose of the League program is to give the youth of our community an opportunity to increase their softball skills by playing in a competitive atmosphere. The main goal of our program is to introduce players the skills and fundamentals of softball. It is also a primary goal of our program to teach our youth how to compete in the proper manner with good sportsmanship and dignity.

The philosophy of "TEAM" first is very important. This is not an individual sport and therefore, most decisions are made with the intention of what is best for the whole team and not just a few individuals. Agreement to this code of conduct is required prior to being allowed to play in the recreational league program. Commitment and dedication are a must for any team and program to be successful.

With this purpose in mind, we ask that each player/guardian agree to the following:

- Ensure that my athlete is at practice and games on time and that she exhibits a positive attitude toward other players and coaches on the team.
- Notify the coach as soon as possible if my daughter is going to miss or be late for practice or a game.
- Always Exhibit good sportsmanship. Treating all opponents with respect.
- Respect and support the coaches, addressing any issues directly and privately, observing
 the 24-hour rule and make myself available in good faith for discussions with members
 of the executive board to resolve issues which may raise concerns towards player safety.
- Not use social media or other forms of electronic communication in a way that may be harmful or damaging to the reputation of the association.
- Act as a positive role model by respecting and obeying umpires. Refrain from criticizing and/or complaining.
- Lead by example, winning and losing with dignity and grace.
- Treat all members of the team, parents, athletes, and coaches with respect.

I understand that negative behavior on my part toward other members of the team, the coaches, or game officials may result in disciplinary action, including dismissal from the team.
